7th & 8th Grades

- 24 pencils - regular size #2 with erasers
- 1 pink eraser
- 1 box colored pencils (set of 12)

- SCHOOL UNIFORM CODE -

ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE FOR STUDENTS

Students are expected to present an appearance that, in the judgment of the faculty/administration, does not disrupt the educational process or interfere with the maintenance of a positive teaching/learning climate or pose a possible threat. Dress and/or grooming which is not in accord with reasonable standards of health, safety, modesty, and decency will be considered inappropriate. The building administrator is the final authority for judging the appropriateness of a student's appearance.

The following items of clothing are not permitted:

- Fashion or materials, which exaggerate, emphasize, reveal, or call attention to anatomical details, or expose undergarments;
- Torn or cut articles of clothing;
- Sleeveless shirts, mesh shirts, or biker shorts;
- Skirts above the extended fingertips;
- Shorts above the extended fingertips;
- Messages on clothing by picture or word may not be lewd, obscene, drug/alcohol oriented, profane or gang related;
- Outer garments (i.e., coats, hats, scarves) cannot be worn during the school day.
- Shoes with wheels (Healies)
- This list is not all-inclusive.

Students' coats, book bags, and backpacks must be left in the student's locker.
