Dear Parents & Students:

At its regular meeting on February 23rd, the Board of Education took action to move the **first through fourth grade students** that reside in the **Lakewood Trails (East of Ridge Road)** subdivision from Aux Sable Elementary School to **Minooka Elementary School** for the 2011-12 school year and beyond. The move was necessary in order to balance the academic offerings at all four of the district's elementary schools.

Due to the increased student enrollments and the opening of new schools, we have found it necessary to review our subdivision boundaries. During these reviews, we have attempted to make as little change as possible to be considerate to the needs of our students and families.

The district's Transportation Committee began discussing this issue last spring and met last fall to review our current situation, student enrollment by subdivision, updated enrollment projections, and discuss options for solving our attendance boundary problem. Two Parent Forums were held to allow parents and students an opportunity to learn more about the challenges the district is facing, view the data used that helped drive the decision, and discuss the proposed changes.
