At Minooka Intermediate School, we like to reward students who exhibit strong character throughout the building. A few ways that we reward these students are Quarterly Reward Parties and Indian Wampums.

Teachers pay special attention to “catch” students demonstrating strong character skills. (What is good character? Students, think back to Day One and the Behavior Matrix, think about the Three R’s) When teachers “catch” students in these good moments, students will be given an Indian Wampum. Students can turn the Wampum into the office for a prize or put the wampum in a drawing for a chance to attend a Friday Wampum Party with Mrs. Staab.

Teachers also keep track of all the students who exhibit strong character and responsibility throughout each quarter. Students can qualify to participate in a Quarterly Reward Party. Parents must give written consent for students to participate in the Quarterly Reward Party via the permission slip given out prior to the party. The criteria to qualify for a party are below.

Quarterly Reward Parties Criteria

5th Grade

- No Missing Assignments
- Must be earning at least 76% in all subject areas
- No behavior referrals or write-ups, includes bus incidents and lunch/after school detentions
- Must have Reward Party permission slips in on time
- 1st Quarter-No more than two late assignments
- 2nd Quarter-No more than one late assignments
- 3rd Quarter-No late assignments
- 4th Quarter-No late assignments

6th Grade:

- No Missing Assignments
- Must be earning at least 76% in all subject areas
- No behavior referrals or write-ups, includes bus incidents and lunch/after school detentions
- Must have Reward Party permission slips in on time
- No late assignments
- Zero “No Dresses” for Physical Education

Remember, rewards are not taken away, but granted to those who earn them!
